Vibrant! A priceless experience! Why don't you become a community/child welfare commissioner?

Do you know community/child welfare commissioners? Have you ever heard of them? Many of you may have heard of them, but might not know what they do. In this issue, we will introduce the activities of community/child welfare commissioners who connect the community and the local government.

• What kind of people are community/child welfare commissioners?

They are volunteers who connect the community and the local government. They are parttime special local government officials commissioned by the Minister of Health, Labor, and Welfare.

Approximately 170 people are active in the Abiko city. The term of office is three years and can be reappointed, so many have been involved for many years. They watch over the community, provide consultation for problems in daily life and child-rearing and connect those who need assistance to the local government and the Council of Social Welfare.

• What is a chief child welfare commissioner?

Among community/child welfare commissioners, there are "chief child welfare commissioners" who specialize in counselling for children and child-rearing households. Working with schools and child guidance centers to support child rearing, they also support community welfare commissioners and child welfare commissioners.
